1. BODRUM KALESİ

Bodrum Castle, which has a square plan, measures 180 x 185 meters. The French Tower is considered the highest point of the castle. It is 47.5 meters high.

It is possible to observe architectural ideas from different nations, and it is believed that many important remains, not yet unearthed, are waiting to be discovered underwater in the ancient city.

Why should you go? Myndos Ancient City is conveniently located on a main road. It's a great spot for taking spectacular photos, especially during sunrise and sunset, making it a must-visit during a trip to Bodrum.

4. MYNDOS KAPISI



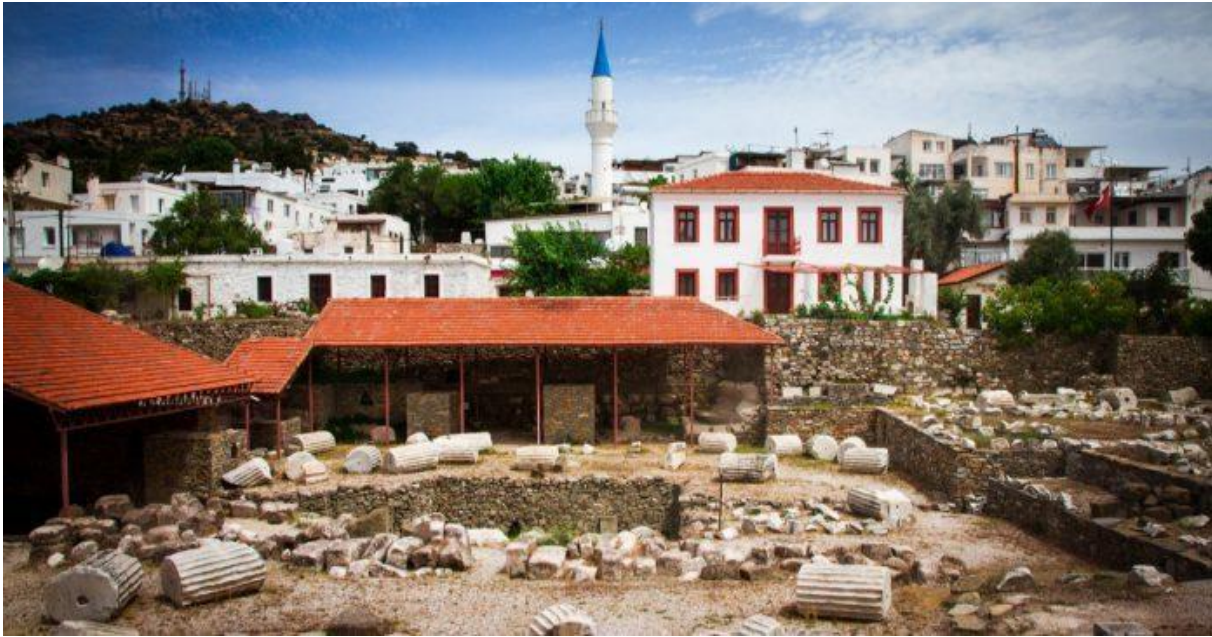
Where is this? The Myndos Gate, It is estimated to have been built in the **360s BC** . The gate was built **by Maussolos, the satrap of Caria**. It was built by [name of person/organization]. It is named after the ancient city of Myndos, where it is located. The impressive gate is among Bodrum's important historical landmarks. Built for defensive purposes, it formed a crucial protective wall for Halicarnassus and fulfilled its duty admirably. Even Alexander the Great, who wanted to conquer the city, could not pass through this gate. Another gate built for the protection of the city is [name of gate]. **The Mylasa Gate has disappeared** .

5. HALIKARNAS MOZOLESİ



Where is this? The Mausoleum of Halicarnassus is one of Bodrum's must-see historical structures. Built in 353 BC by King Mausolus' wife and sister, it is also known as the " **Tomb of King Mausolus** ." Today, it is a museum-like tomb monument located quite close to Bodrum Castle. The mausoleum represents both Greek and Egyptian architecture .

Stones from the Mausoleum of Halicarnassus, Basement During the construction of the castle It has been used. The monument approximately 1500 It is believed to have stood for many years before being destroyed by an earthquake. The remaining parts of the museum are on display **at the British Museum** .

Why should I go? Although not much remains of the Mausoleum of Halicarnassus, considered one of the Seven Wonders of the World, it is one of the most important historical sites that absolutely must be seen. It is among them.

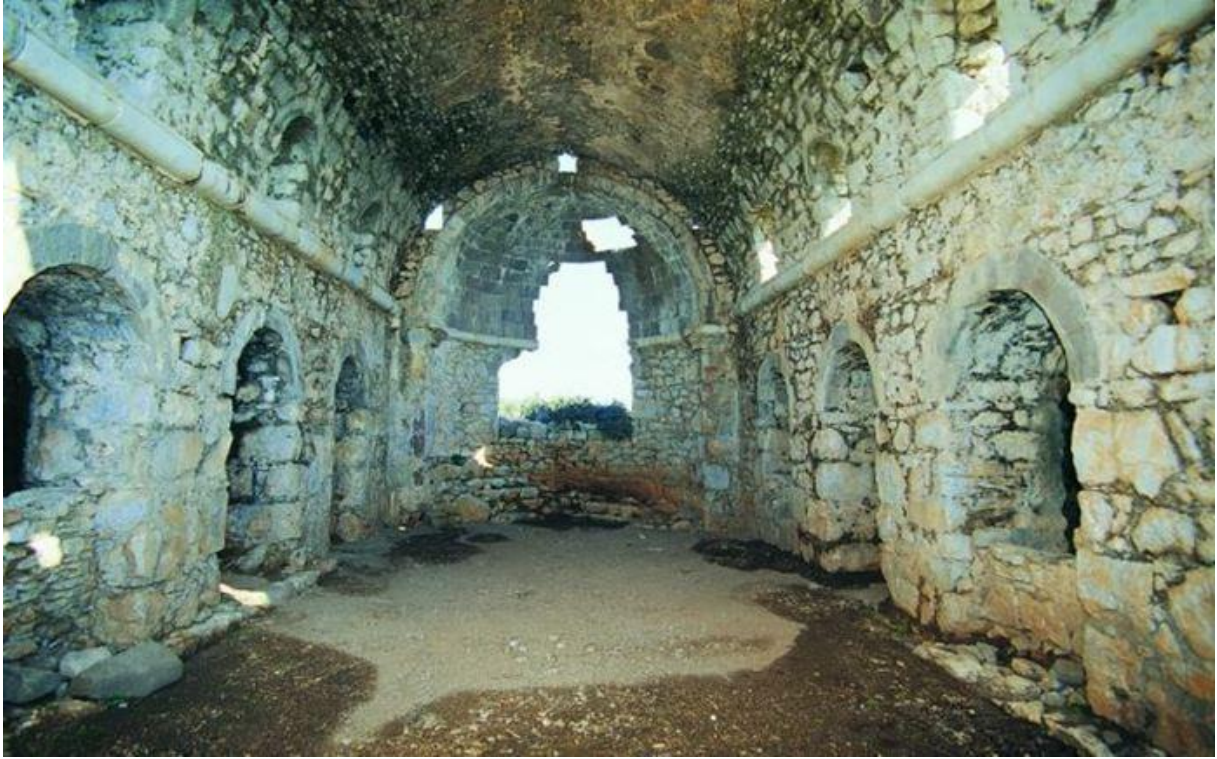
Don't miss it! We also recommend that you don't miss the impressive marina view that awaits you when you climb to the top of the shipyard.

10. APOSTOL KİLİSESİ

It is believed that various additions were made to the church between the 6th and 12th centuries. The island is also called " **Island of the Saint Apostles** " because of the church. It was built with similar features to the Hagia Sophia Mosque . the two structures around the same time It is thought to have been built in Italy . The church was constructed in a basilica style. It is protected by Türkiye and is a hidden treasure for history lovers.

Why should I go? The restoration work carried out by both Italy and Turkey since 1996 shows us how important a religious site the church is for the world. That is precisely why we believe the Church of the Apostles should definitely be on a list of must-see historical places in Bodrum.

Don't miss it! The church is located in an area that also boasts a spectacular view, so don't miss the opportunity to enjoy the scenery.

However, a large part of the responsibility for preserving historical sites falls on the tourists who visit these places. It is declining. If we want these cultural heritages to be passed on to future generations without damage, there are certain rules we must follow during our visit.

- ✓ Date from places any One object should not be taken.
- ✓ Environment It should not be polluted.
- ✓ Any One in the field No fire should be lit.
- ✓ Date to the works It should not be touched.
- ✓ Date to buildings And to the works writing should not be written, picture It should not be scratched.
- ✓ When passing through confined spaces, care should be taken to prevent bags and other personal belongings from damaging the historical artifact.
- ✓ Religious And cultural sensitivities suitable in a way behavior should be observed.

Rules to be followed in natural areas :

- ✓ Leave no trace: Collect all trash and food scraps and take them with you.
- ✓ Be careful with fire: Only light fires in permitted areas; do not light uncontrolled fires and ensure they are completely extinguished.
- ✓ Protect wildlife: Do not feed or disturb the animals; observe them from a distance.
- ✓ Do not disturb the vegetation: Do not pick flowers or plants; do not break tree branches.
- ✓ Stay on the designated paths: Use the trails to prevent erosion and avoid getting lost.
- ✓ Do not pollute water sources: Do not use soap, detergent, or chemicals near streams and lakes.
- ✓ Keep quiet: Don't speak loudly and avoid using speakers.
- ✓ Only camp in designated areas: pitch your tents in designated areas and do not damage the environment.
